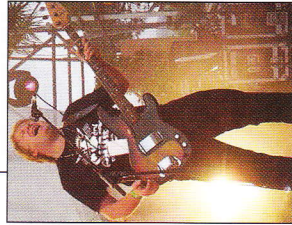


MUSIC & GIG GUIDE

During a recent charity event at the George & Dragon in Chesham, I had the pleasure of meeting Rob Sas, and what a pleasure it did indeed turn out to be.

I was left open mouthed from the very first few seconds, he has an extraordinary talent, man this guy can play and play he did! On this occasion he was performing solo, but later I grabbed an opportune moment and had a chat with him about his band, 'Burn'.

Burn were originally formed in the summer of 1993, John and Rob met via then keyboard player Tom Dussek after an originals band folded and the decision was made to form a covers band. Ross Elder joined the band a couple of years later after dissatisfaction with their then current drummer, Ross left in February this year and Garry Randal then joined as Burn's current drummer.

All of the band are relatively local, Rob, originally from Chalfont St Giles, is now living in Ley Hill, John has made a significant move from Glasgow to Slough and Garry from Debden in Essex is now settled in Hitchin. I asked Rob how they all started on the ladder. "Our musical backgrounds are quite varied, I'm from the rock scene and since my teens I have played in various rock bands including some well known names."

"Garry is also from a rock background, he moved to the USA for a while with a band in search of a recording deal. John spent his formative years playing in and around Glasgow before moving to the London area where he performed with many bands playing a variety of genres".

When you listen to 'Burn', you immediately know they share an obvious passion for Deep Purple, in 2008 Rob was invited to play with 24 Carat Purple, a Deep Purple tribute band, he now splits his time between these and several other outfits, a busy man for sure!

They have a huge repertoire including some of their favorites, songs like Catch The Rainbow, Born To Be Wild, Highway Star, Day Of The Eagle, all passionately and energetically performed for the audiences and listening pleasure, there's nothing half hearted about their approach to the music, you get exactly what you're expecting (and a lot more besides) from a solid 'classic rock' covers band!

So Rob, let's reminisce, share some magic moments with us: "The first time I played onstage with Nic Simper (original Deep Purple bassist) would be one. Our Danish tours were very memorable and then there is the time at one gig where some random punter decided to set up some bongos near me at a gig in Watford and played very much out of time, lets just say that he had to be 'discouraged' quite forcefully to shut up!"

"One interesting time was when I was with former Status Quo drummer John Coghlan, we were flown out to Switzerland to play at a huge festival for 5,000 people, we flew back the next day in time for me to play a duo gig in Edgware ... to five people and a dog!"

And I am confident that like the true professionals you are the show went on?: "Yes of course!" I could waffle on forever about how good these guys are, simply stunning musicians and John has a voice that any classic rock enthusiast would die for, that perfect gravelly edge that grabs you by the parts of the male anatomy that shall remain nameless, just truly awesome!

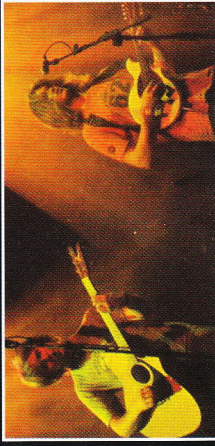
Events that you simply need to know about!
